Revision of the Greek Constitution in 2001

The Commission submitted to the Greek government and the parliamentary political parties recommendations regarding the forthcoming revision of the Greek Constitution. It proposed amendments to a series of constitutional provisions in relation to: conscientious objection to military service; abolition of the death penalty under any circumstances (the death penalty in time of peace has been abolished in Greece); protection of personal data; the right of association of civil servants; Greek mass media; the right to property; the protection of natural and cultural environment; the participation of civil servants in national elections as candidates; the competence of the Greek Council of State; and the Greek independent administrative authorities.
