Recommendations for the Protection of the Rights of Mentally Disabled Persons Subject to Criminal Security Measures

Taking into account the international and European developments in the area of protection of the above particularly vulnerable persons, the NCHR proposed to the Ministry of Justice a series of amendments to criminal law for the enhancement of the protection of these persons. In particular the NCHR submitted to the Greek State the following major proposals:

(a) Amendment of criminal law so that detention of the above persons is ordered solely by courts following open court sessions;

(b) The detention should be primarily conditioned on the existence of the relevant pathology and not on vague legal conditions such as "danger to public safety";

(c) Amendment of legislation so that detention is subject to a complete judicial control as prescribed by contemporary international and European human rights standards;

(d) The entrenchment in Greek law of the right of the mentally disabled to be present in all relevant judicial proceedings.
