**The President of the Hellenic Republic Katerina Sakellariopoulou
at the GNCHR Plenary on the International Human Rights Day 2020**



The Greek National Commission for Human Rights (GNCHR) has the honour and the pleasure to welcome the President of the Hellenic Republic Katerina Sakellariopoulou to a special Plenary meeting in celebration of the International Human Rights Day, on Thursday, 10 December 2020.

It is the first time in the 20 years of operation of the National Commission, that the Hellenic Republic, in the presence of the President, pays tribute to the contribution of the National Human Rights Institution to the respect and promotion of human rights in this country.

The Greek National Commission for Human Rights (GNCHR) is the independent advisory body to the Greek State on matters pertaining to human rights protection. It was established by Law 2667/1998 and is functioning in accordance with the UN Paris Principles. Its 41 members are nominated by institutions whose activities cover the field of human rights (NGOs, trade unions, independent authorities, universities, bar associations, political parties, Parliament and the Administration).
